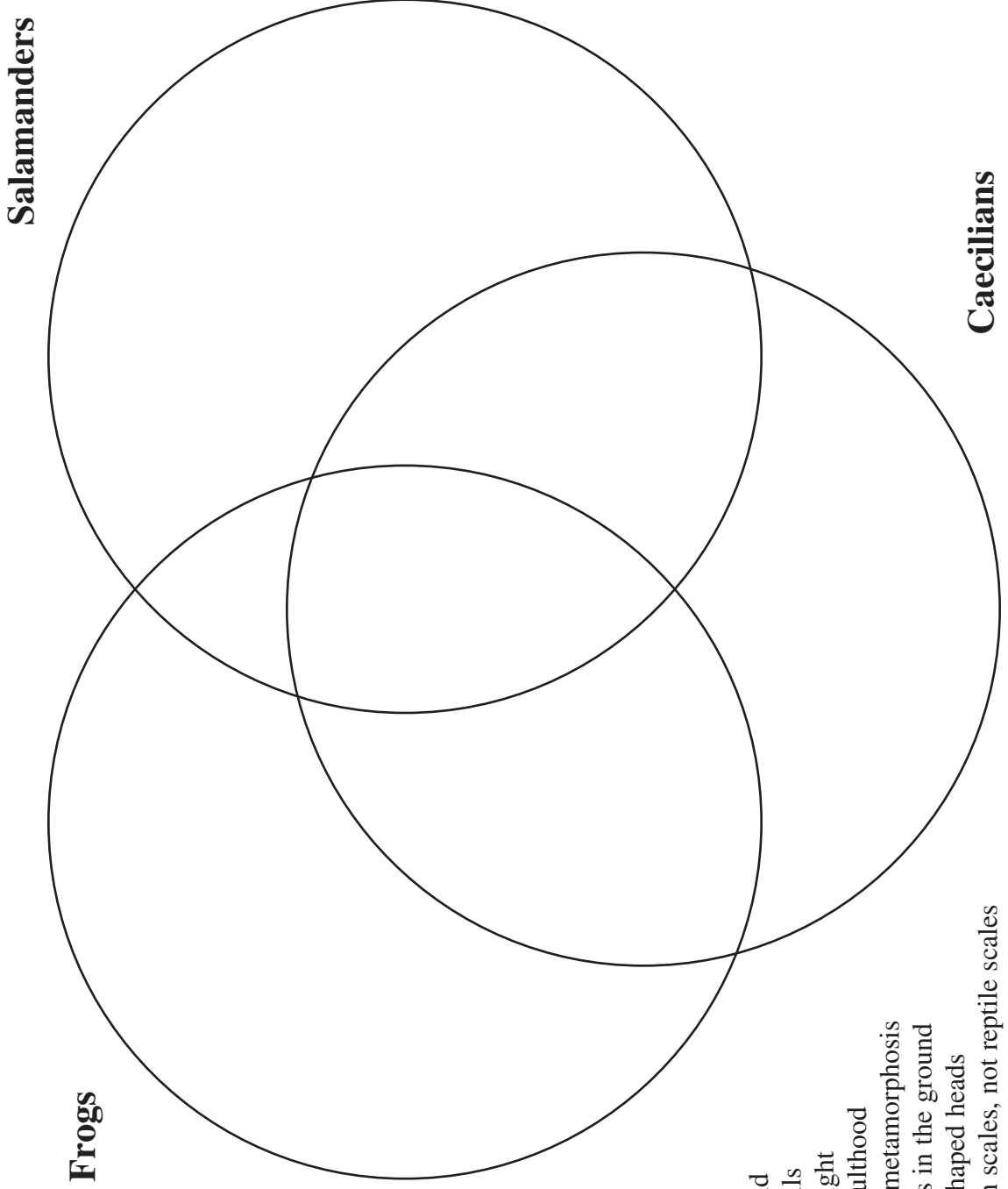


# Amphibians Venn Diagram

Amphibians are animals that live on land and/or in water at some time during their developmental stages and adulthood. Decide how the following characteristics should be placed on the Venn diagram.



## Characteristics

- No claws
- Are legless
- Moist skin
- Cold-blooded
- No scaly skin
- Are carnivorous
- Have vocal sacs
- Eggs are shell-less
- Eat worms and insects
- Have a strong sense of smell
- Spend most of the time on land
- Can make loud, distinctive calls
- Rest during the day, hunt at night
- Replace gills with lungs in adulthood
- Never go through a complete metamorphosis
- Ears are sensitive to vibrations in the ground
- Burrows are dug with bullet-shaped heads
- Are bony scales similar to fish scales, not reptile scales
